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Advanced Placement courses at Oakleaf High School are extremely rigorous and are intended for students who have demonstrated both the highest level of academic achievement and a commitment to hard work. Since AP courses are designed to prepare students for college-level, subject specific, AP exams, the materials covered are extensive and the pace, rapid. Many students are not prepared for the pace and rigor of an AP course. For those that choose to take an AP course, it is expected that they will complete the pre-course/summer requirements specific to that course and that they will remain in the course the entire school year. Students will be allowed to sign up for three (3) AP courses per year without prior approval. **Any student wishing to take four (4) or more AP courses must have prior administrative approval from the AP Coordinator or the Principal.** If a student struggles with an AP course, it is expected that they will commit themselves to a greater effort and seek regular support services, one of which could be tutoring. Due to budget constraints, it is imperative that we maintain maximum class sizes in our advanced courses and thus *students who both choose and are scheduled into AP course(s) will be required to remain in the course(s)*. It is important that you give careful consideration to your schedule and extra-curricular activities to ensure that you are going to be able to manage your AP courses along with your other responsibilities. **AP courses and their course work supersede athletics and other extra-curricular activities.**

There will be no schedule changes.
