

DUAL ENROLLMENT

For questions or to sign up for Dual Enrollment classes, contact Mrs. Hatcher in the OHS School Counseling office. You will need to coordinate with both your assigned School Counselor and Mrs. Hatcher to ensure that you are meeting both graduation and dual enrollment requirements.

Dual Enrollment is only open to Juniors and Seniors who meet the criteria established below. We highly recommend that students take Honors and/or AP level classes prior to attempting Dual Enrollment courses.

Dual Enrollment:

- College level coursework completed through St. Johns River State College- SJRSC
- Coursework counts for both high school credit and college credit
- Course grades become a permanent part of a student's college transcript and can impact future enrollment eligibility and financial aid
- Course grades do not reflect in the Clay County Focus (Parent Portal) system until the class is finished and the professor finalizes the grade
- Students must use the SJR system to track progress, turn in assignments, and communicate with the professors
- Course credit accepted by Florida State University schools; however, it is at their discretion how that credit is applied to your degree work
- It is the student's responsibility to communicate with their college advisor on how the courses they take fit into the college degree program they will be pursuing
- Dual Enrollment is generally the better choice for students who plan to enroll to complete their A.A. degree at the state college level before transferring to a larger university

Math - Intermediate Algebra (MAT 1033)

(Elective Credit)

ACT: Math - 19

SAT: Math - 24

CPT: Elementary Algebra - 72

PERT: Math - 114

Math - College Algebra (MAC 1105)

(Math Credit)

ACT: Math - 21

SAT: Math - 25

CPT: Elementary Algebra - 85

PERT: Math - 123

You must have the minimum of these scores to be college ready, Mix and match you best scores from these tests. Test scores must be less than two years old. You must submit a copy of your official student score report.. When submitting test scores, make sure the report has your first and last name printed on it.
