- Students who choose to post editorial content to websites or other forms of online media must ensure that their submission does not reflect poorly upon the school.

Failure to abide by this Policy, as with other policies at Oakleaf high, may result in disciplinary action as described in the Student Handbook, or as determined by the Administrative Staff of Oakleaf High School.
